SPRING BRUSH COLLECTION ~ WEEK OF APRIL 8TH

Spring Township will be having its Spring Brush Collection starting Monday, April 8, 2019, weather permitting. They will go over each street **ONE TIME ONLY**. If you wish to have your brush picked up, please follow these instructions:

- ✓ **ALL** limbs must be placed along the curb, **PARALLEL TO THE ROAD**.
- ✓ **ALL** limbs must be placed out prior to 7:00 a.m. Monday morning, April 8, 2019, so that you are not missed. **ONCE THE ROAD CREW HAS GONE OVER A STREET THEY WILL NOT GO BACK.**
- ✓ **NO** limbs larger than 4" in diameter and **NO** more than one load of brush will be accepted per household. **This collection is for trimming of bushes and trees, not for tree removal or site clearing.**

It is important that these instructions are followed to ensure the safety of our Road Crew and proper operation and care of our equipment. IF THESE INSTRUCTIONS ARE NOT FOLLOWED YOUR BRUSH WILL NOT BE PICKED UP!!!

The Road Crew will begin sweeping the streets after brush collection is over. If you have any additional questions, please feel free to call the office at (814) 355-7543 ext. 105. Thank you!

Soon springtime will be here, and with that our grasses and shrubs will grow quickly. Township regulations require that yards need to be mowed on a regular basis and restricts grass and weeds to a maximum height of 6 inches. As we look forward to cleaning up our properties in the upcoming spring season, please also remember that in order to burn your brush your property needs to have a minimum of 3 acres.

Spring Township also has regulations that require trash to be stored in proper containers and that properties are to obtain the services of a licensed trash hauler. Without proper storage and regular collection, trash can become a public nuisance and a health hazard.

The Township's sewage management program will continue in 2019. For those who had their properties inspected 6 years ago you will be asked to have your septic system pumped and inspected again this year. These forms will be mailed soon so please return your information forms and the inspection fee as soon as possible so that we may schedule your inspection!

Lastly, please remember that any home improvement projects you may wish to do this year may require building and zoning permits. To ensure the needed amount of time to process your permits, please submit your applications as far in advance of your project as you are able.

WATER AUTHORITY

ATTENTION: Spring Township Water Authority Customers!!

Due to increasing costs on maintaining the system and the installation of the new well project, Effective January 1, 2019, your water rates have changed! The new rate will be \$5.00 per 1,000 gallons used plus the \$20.00 base fee per quarter. Customers will notice the change on the April 15, 2019 billing quarter.

We also highly encourage customers to make sure when paying on line you are paying your water bill. We are separate from the sewer office, which is Spring-Benner-Walker Joint Authority. If we receive a payment from someone who is not a customer, we can only refund the monies we received. We cannot refund the fee charged by Pay Pal for paying online. These monies do not come to The Authority. If we receive a payment that is not ours, monies are transferred from our Pay Pal Account into the checking account so a check can be cut to issue a refund which is typically at the end of each month after approved at a Water Authority meeting. **Please be careful which website you are on before making a payment.**

As Spring/Summer will be approaching, customers will be anxious to get outside and wash vehicles, plant gardens, etc., but as always try to remember water is a precious commodity and we need to remember to **“USE WATER WISELY!”**

TIPS FROM TOBY Water Operator

Here is a little tip to help reduce your water usage and keep your bill at the appropriate amount. Periodically or month, check your home for leaking water. When you are not using any water, look at your water meter for a couple of minutes and make sure that none of the numbers are scrolling (on the plastic I-Perl meter) or that little triangle is turning (brass SR2 meter). If you experience this situation, you have something leaking in your home. Most of the time it is a leaking toilet or outside hose bib. This should be addressed as soon as possible.

A ½ gallon per minute water leak used 720 gallons per day or 64,000 gallons per quarter. A full quarter of a leak this size would result in your water bill being an additional \$320. I hope this helps you reduce any unnecessary water usage.
